



NSW TBA Inc STATE AWARDS POLICY

February 2021

Objective

The objective for establishing the State Awards is to recognise these outstanding individuals who can hold up as role models for our sport and the importance of the individuals and volunteers behind the sport of tenpin bowling in NSW.

Recognition through NSW State Awards relates to:

- Athletes who have demonstrated sustained performances at the highest levels in the sport of tenpin bowling for the year of nomination.
- Administrators, Officials, Coaches and Volunteers who have made an extraordinary, inspirational and dedicated personal contribution to tenpin bowling and the development in NSW.

Awards

NSW Tenpin Bowling Association State Awards will be given for the following:

- Junior Bowler of the Year – Male and Female (Must not have attained the age of 18 by 1st of January in year of the award)
- Youth Bowler of the Year – Male and Female (Must not have attained the age of 21 by 1st of January in year of the award)
- Adult Bowler of the Year – Male and Female (Must be 18 or over in year of award)
- Senior Bowler of the Year – Male and Female (Must be turning 50 or over in year of award)
- Athlete with Disability Bowler of the Year (Must meet the criteria as defined by TBA)
- Coach of the Year (Must be currently TBA Accredited)
- NSW TBA Representative Team of the Year
- Volunteer of the Year – by nomination
- Volunteer recognition – by nomination

Individuals or Teams must be active members of Tenpin Bowling Australia (TBA) and must have resided in NSW for the majority of the period for which they are being considered.

Category Criteria

Bowler of the Year – Junior, Youth, Adult, Senior and Disabilities

This award is performance based and will include the following age appropriate events:

- Recognised NSW accredited tournaments
- State Championships
- State Team Trials and participation
- National Championships
- National Ranked Tournaments
- National Team Participation

Also the following attributes will be noted:

- Integrity
- Exemplary sportsmanship
- Affability
- Respect for others
- Support for the values of the sport NSW Tenpin Bowling Association and Tenpin Bowling Australia

Coach of the Year

This award recognises significant achievements and contributions of coaches to the NSW Tenpin Bowling. The following criteria will be used to assess suitability:

- Length of time volunteer coaching

- Different coaching roles performed
- Number of athletes coached
- Outcomes achieved through coaching
- Extent the coach has had a positive influence on athletes

Also the following attributes will be noted:

- Integrity
- Respect for others
- Support for the values of the sport, NSW Tenpin Bowling Association and Tenpin Bowling Australia

Representative Team of the Year

This award is performance based and will include all NSW State Teams participation and results.

Volunteer of the Year

This award recognises our very best volunteers NSW Tenpin Bowling has to offer.

The following criteria will be used to assess the suitability of the nominations:

- Length of time volunteering
- Role and responsibilities as a volunteer
- Outcomes achieved through volunteering
- Effect of their activities on the sport of Tenpin Bowling in NSW

Volunteer Recognition (3)

This award recognises and values the contribution of our volunteer does:

- Tournament Team
- Association and Administration
- Centre / League Official
- And other roles that volunteers play in the continued success of Tenpin Bowling in NSW

Nomination Process

Nominations for Volunteer State Awards can be made by any current financial member of Tenpin Bowling Australia other than the individual being nominated.

A completed nomination form (below) addressing why the person should be eligible under the criteria needs to be forwarded to the TBANSW State Championships and Roll Off Tournament Secretary.

All Bowler / Team / Coach of the Year Awards are performance based and will be considered by TBANSW. Successful nominations will be voted by the TBANSW State Advisory Committee.

Any decision by the TBANSW Advisory Committee in relation to nominations for the State Awards shall be final and no appeal can be made in relation to the decision and no correspondence will be entered into. Decisions of the TBANSW State Advisory Committee will be based on a simple majority.

TBANSW State Advisory Committee

This Committee is made up of various members from across the Tenpin Bowling community who are devoted in providing high-level support, leadership, and direction across essential sporting and organisational portfolio areas.
