# **Tenpin Bowling Australia's Rules and Regulations and Tenpin Bowling Australia's Code of Ethics will apply to this Tournament**

**COVID-19 – Statement and Impact** - Given the current and ever-changing circumstances with COVID-19, it is crucial that all participants, volunteers, administrators, parents/carers, and/or anyone associated with the NSW Disability State Championships and Paper Masters adhere to the current COVID-19 requirements, procedures and guidelines implemented by the NSW State Government, NSW Health and well as the guidelines set out by the venue.

Based on current advice spectators will be allowed during the tournament, unless government guidelines are changed before the commencement of the tournament whereby it may be restricted to just one support person for the disabled athlete.

The event venue/will be adequately equipped with COVID-19 practice protocols including hygiene, COVID Safety Marshalls and stations for hygienic purposes, electronic QR code check in points, hand sanitiser stations, temperature checkpoints, and allocated spacing to ensure we comply with NSW state and federal government 1.5m square metre rule policies.

**Bowlers must comply with STRICTLY NO CONTACT - no High Fives, Handshakes or Huddles during the event.**

TBA NSW requests that all athletes and their support person always carry a face mask for preparedness if the state government rules on COVID-19 restrictions change. TBA NSW will always adhere with the state government and NSW Health directives. When face masks are imposed to be worn this will be enforced and those who do not wear face masks will not be permitted to bowl or enter the centre. Bowler's entry for their specific event will be deemed forfeited. Exceptions will be on submission of a medical certificate explaining the reason for inability to wear a face mask.

**TBA NSW expects bowlers to follow all relevant TBA and TBA NSW rules, regulations and Code of Ethics including policies and procedures with emphasis on the rules below.**

## **Eligibility Conditions and Rules**

1. All bowlers must be current TBA Registered Members and meet the requirements of a bowler with a Disability under TBA Rule 214.
2. A bowler with a disability is defined as a person who suffers from a condition that has limitation, restriction or impairment that restricts everyday activity. The condition is permanent. It should be noted that degree or degrees of pain are not considered a disability.

To prove a disability, a participant needs to provide one of the following types of evidence:

**Please note that evidence of Disability as defined below will need to be shown at time of check in. If unable to provide you will not be allowed to bowl.**

- Valid Disability Support Pension Card (DSP)
- Recipient of the Child Disability Allowance
- Classification Card issued by Tenpin Bowling Australia, Deaf Sports Australia, Blind Sports Australia, Wheelchair Sports Australia or Sport Inclusion Australia (or State affiliated organisation)
- Letter from a medical or educational professional:
  - Physiotherapist or Occupational Therapist
  - Principal of Primary, Secondary or Tertiary Education Organisation
  - Psychologist

- General Medical Practitioner
  - Audiologist
  - Ophthalmologist
  - Visual evidence in the case of short statured or participants that are amputees. An amputation is required at the site of major joint. For example, the loss of a foot or both feet, an arm or both arms
3. A bowler **must** be bowling in a Disability or Open three (3) game Registered League in a TBA accredited centre regularly i.e. weekly or fortnightly.
  4. Must reside in NSW
  5. **No refund after entries close.** Teams or Individuals who do not bowl in their allocated squads will not be entitled to claim a refund. Teams or Individuals who are unable to bowl in their event can sell their spot to another competitor Whilst the Tournament Committee will help where possible to reschedule entries, it is not their responsibility to sell or recover money for unused entries
  6. **Dress Code** - Bowler's must wear **black** dress pants, **black** shorts, **black** skirts or **black** skorts and a collared shirt. **No** jeans or coloured pants/shorts, T-shirts, tank tops or hats allowed during bowling (hats for vision impaired bowlers exempted). **If proper clothes are not worn, you will not be allowed to bowl.**
  7. **Entering Averages** – Averages will be checked. Providing a false average will lead to an automatic disqualification.

Each bowler must use their highest current league average as at 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021 which has been established over a minimum of 18 games in a registered league.

A print out of the bowler's full individual league history from the bowling centre **must** be attached with the entry form. **No exceptions.**

8. **Grading** – Entries will be graded in accordance with the Disability Championship Grading Table above and based on averages submitted by the bowler.
9. **Bowlers without an average** – Any bowler without an average may apply to the tournament committee for grading prior to submitting an entry. If no application is received, then the entering average will be 170 for Males and 150 for Females.
10. **Replacements** – Any change from the original Entry or line-up must be reported to the Tournament Team at least 1/2 hour before the scheduled starting time.
11. **Games to be played** – In each Grade a three (3) game series will be played in Teams Doubles and Singles.
12. **Multiple Participation is allowed**

**Teams** of 3 bowlers Event – Bowlers may have a maximum of 3 entries however at least one bowler must be changed.

**Doubles** Event – Bowlers may have a maximum of 3 entries however one bowler must be different

**Singles** Event – Bowlers may have a maximum of 3 and entries must be in their own grade

13. **All Events** – Payment of the \$5.00 All Events Fee must be received with the entry form. An All Events Champion will be declared for each grade in which paid entries are received. Scores from each bowler's **first** Teams, Doubles and Singles game will count towards their All Event total.
14. **Smoking and Consumption of Alcohol** is banned during the Championships games. Disobeying this rule will incur penalties defined in the TBA Code of Ethics.
15. **Bad behaviour, bad sportsmanship and swearing** will not be tolerated. Anyone in breach of this rule will face immediate disqualification.
16. **Mobile Phones** are banned from the lanes and must be turned off while competing in an event. Anyone found disobeying this rule will be immediately disqualified.
17. **Awards.**
  - Medals will be presented for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in all grades for Singles, Doubles and Teams.
  - All Events Trophy will be presented for 1<sup>st</sup> place in each grade Male and Female and medals for All Events 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placing.
  - Trophies will be presented in each grade for Highest Game overall (Male & Female) and highest over average (Male & Female)
18. **Injury or Damages** – Bowlers and visitors indemnify TBA NSW from any injury, accident and damage to equipment whilst competing during the championships or visiting the centre.
19. **NOTE** any matters arising that are not covered by these tournament rules will be determined by the TBANSW State Advisory Committee.

## 2022 TBA NSW State Disability Championships Individual or Group Disability Bowler Competitors Information

### Open, Classic and Restricted Paper Masters

The Paper Masters format has been used over the years at TBA NSW State Championships instead of the usual format. Paper Masters allows a smoother running of the State Championships as it is easier, involves less bowling time and all awards are presented at the same time.

#### Eligibility

To participate in this event, nominated bowlers **must** complete an All Events at this 2022 TBA NSW State Disability Championships **plus** select 1 other series in either Singles, Doubles or Teams on Saturday or Sunday.

**The nomination fee is \$25.00 and must be paid at the same time that the Nomination Form is returned along with the TBA NSW State Disability Championships paperwork.**

#### Which Division would I bowl in?

Open Masters – **Mixed Event** - Male and Female – Average 160 and above

Classic Masters – **Mixed Event** - Male and Female – Average 120 - 159

Restricted Masters – **Mixed Event** - Male and Female – Average 119 and below

#### So how does it work?

##### Open Masters

If you have nominated for the Paper Masters, before bowling your first series of the Championship, you must select **one other series** (either singles, doubles or teams) to count towards your score. All scores from your All Events will then be added to the series you have selected. The highest pin fall will win 1<sup>st</sup> place. The next highest gains 2<sup>nd</sup> place and the next highest gains 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

In the event of a tie, the first selected series played will be used to break the tie. If still tied, the first selected series and second selected series will be used etc. until the tie is broken and a winner is decided.

##### Classic and Restricted Masters

If you have nominated for the Paper Masters, before bowling your first series of the Championship, you must select **one other series** (either singles, doubles or teams) to count towards your score plus the handicap (100% of 200). All scores from your All Events will then be added to the series you have selected (plus handicap). The highest pin fall including the handicap (100% of 200) will win 1<sup>st</sup> place. The next highest gains 2<sup>nd</sup> place and the next highest gains 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

In the event of a tie the handicap will be added to the first selected series played to break the tie. If still tied, the handicap will be added to the first selected series and second selected series etc. until the tie is broken and a winner is decided.

##### Prizes

**1<sup>st</sup> place** – All Divisions will receive a Trophy, Shirt, Certificate and automatic paid spot in the 2022 Masters at the 33<sup>rd</sup> National Disability Tenpin Bowling Championship being held at Epping, Victoria

**2<sup>nd</sup> place** – All Divisions will receive a Medal and Certificate

**3<sup>rd</sup> place** – All Divisions will receive a Medal and Certificate
